Eagle, ID - Come celebrate with the City of Eagle to honor Eagle High School graduate and Paralympic Silver Medalist, Kory Puderbaugh!

The celebration will take place on Thursday, November 10, at the Eagle Public Library (100 N. Stierman Way), from 6:00pm – 8:00pm. Kory will be arriving with an escort by the Eagle Police Department to get the event started.

Puderbaugh, age 20, was the youngest member of the US Wheelchair Rugby Team, and scored 10 goals during the exciting finals, which went to double overtime. Both Team Australia and Team USA were undefeated going into the final match. Team Australia narrowly beat Team USA by a score of 59-58.

Kory has succeeded despite all odds, having spent the first five years of his life in a Polish orphanage. He continues to train with the San Diego Sharp Wheelchair Rugby Team, and says “We’re waiting for the next chance” in international competition.
