RE: CITY RESPONSE TO THE DIRTY DASH EVENT

Eagle, ID – The City of Eagle, Eagle Fire Protection District, and the Eagle Police are committed to working with event organizers to help them produce a successful and safe event which has minimal negative impact on the environment, surrounding neighborhoods and businesses. A large event, such as this, suggests a major impact on the Ada/Eagle Sports Complex. As there is no completed application, such safety and environmental concerns cannot be successfully addressed before the suggested October 22 event. The City of Eagle will continue to develop and groom the Ada/Eagle Sports Complex to facilitate the suggested uses it is established for including hiking, mountain biking and equestrian leisure. We appreciate the support of our community and look forward to future successful events.

The City of Eagle's Community Event Application policy states as follows:

- Individuals or groups proposing new events will schedule a consultation meeting with the Parks and Recreation Director.
- Community Events Applications must be received by the Eagle's Parks and Recreation Department a minim of thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled date of the event and may be submitted as early as twelve (12) months before the event. At this time, the City of Eagle has not received a completed Large Event Application.

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
