

The Library has great online services. Downloadable audiobooks are a great way to read while you're on the go. In addition to the audiobooks available to you through the Library's Overdrive collection, you now have access to over 5,000 titles through OneClick Digital. To begin using this service, visit the library's webpage and click on either the OneClick Digital logo or the **E-AudioBooks** button.

The Library is now offering streaming movies through IndieFlix. Founded by filmmakers, IndieFlix curates the best worldwide film festivals to make sure independent films have an audience. Filmmakers work hard to create these incredible films and movie lovers deserve to be able to see them. To begin using IndieFlix, visit the library's webpage and click on either the IndieFlix logo or the **Movies** button.

You're now able to download five (5) songs per week (they're yours forever) **AND** stream music for three hours per day per card through the Library's Freegal subscription, a collection of over 9,000,000 songs from thousands of music labels. This is an increase in the number of songs you're able to download each week, from three to five. To stream or download music from Freegal, visit the library's webpage (eaglepubliclibrary.org) and click on the **Music** button. Freegal is also available on mobile devices.

The Library's game collection continues to grow. If you haven't seen it for a while, be sure to stop by and browse the collection. You can also see the complete game collection through the library's catalog. Access the catalog at eaglepubliclibrary.org, click on the catalog button, choose which version of the catalog you prefer to use, and then type: eagle game collection.
