

We're half-way through the library's Summer Reading Program, and there's still plenty of time to register and help your kids be ready for school. Your kids determine how many books they'll read by July 31, and if they read the agreed-to number of books and report to Library staff about just a few of them, they'll earn weekly prizes and be invited to a special evening to celebrate their achievement. It's an easy and fun way to avoid the "summer slide", the decline of reading skills that occurs during the summer months.

Fit and Fall Proof is now offered at the Library. This free exercise-based fall prevention program for older adults focuses on functional exercises that reduce the risk of falling. It's a great way to help stay active and safe. Fit and Fall Proof meets every Tuesday and Thursday at 1:00 pm in the meeting room.

You're able to download five (5) songs per week (they're yours forever) **AND** stream music for three hours per day per card through the Library's Freegal subscription, a collection of over 10,000,000 songs from thousands of music labels.
