

Thanks to the generosity of the Friends of the Eagle Public Library, the Library has a collection of Alzheimer's and dementia therapy resources that include puzzles, games, and manipulatives available to be checked out. Look for this new collection near the large print books. And please remember to support the Friends of the Eagle Public Library through their book sales; the Friends provide valuable support to the Library for children's summer reading programs, audiobooks, and special collections.

If you're an ebook reader and haven't used the ebook collection in a while, you may be happy to know that the collection has grown considerably. The collection of both e-books and e-audiobooks are available to be read on e-readers, tablets, and computers. The titles available cover a wide range of genres and topics – browse the collection, you're sure to find a title of interest. The best part is that titles may be borrowed without ever having to leave your home and never accrue late fees. The Library's seed collection is available once again. Eagle Public Library guests may check-out seeds to plant in their gardens. The gardeners are asked to let the best plant go to seed at the end of the growing season, and then harvest the seeds and return them to the Library where they will be processed for distribution to guests next year.
