The City of Eagle has several opportunities for individuals to serve in a variety of ways. This is an excellent chance to give back to your community and positively impact the future of the City. Please review the information below and take a moment to apply if an opening piques your interest.

Eagle Arts Commission:

The City of Eagle is seeking individuals to fill openings on the Eagle Arts Commission. Priority will be given to Eagle residents, however all interested parties are welcome to apply. Individuals will serve a three (3) year term on the Commission. Meetings are held on the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 8:30 a.m.

Historic Preservation Commission:

The City of Eagle is seeking individuals to fill openings on the Commissions. Individuals must demonstrate interest, competence or knowledge in history or historic preservation. Experience in the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, urban planning, archaeology, engineering, law or other historic preservation related disciplines preferred. Individuals will serve five (5) year term on the Commission. Meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month at 5:30 p.m.

Industrial Development Corporation Board:

The City of Eagle is seeking interested individuals to fill an opening on the Industrial Development Corporation Board. The purpose of the Industrial Development Corporation is to encourage economic development and to help provide jobs in the city by providing tax-exempt bond financing for eligible economic development projects. Under current law, that is restricted to projects which constitute "manufacturing". Individuals will serve a two (2) year term on the Board. The Board meets annually, typically in December.

Public Library Board of Trustees:

The Eagle Public Library Board of Trustees currently has a vacancy. The appointment will be to a five-year term ending September 30, 2020. Duties include attending monthly Board meetings, planning for the Library's future, promoting the Library, seeking funding for the Library, representing the Library at local and state meetings. Applicants must be residents of the City of Eagle.

Design Review Board Opening:

The City of Eagle is seeking individuals to fill an opening on the Design Review Board. Priority will be given to Eagle Residents. Interested parties must possess professional expertise in the area of construction management. The Board regularly meets on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month at 6:00 pm. This is a volunteer position filled via the recommendation of the Mayor and subsequent approval of the City Council.

Those who wish to be considered for one of the above referenced openings are required to complete a Request for Consideration form (available at www.cityofeagle.org and at Eagle City Hall 660 E. Civic Ln. Eagle, ID) and submit a letter of interest. A resume or curriculum vitae are encouraged.
