## **EAGLE NEEDS YOU!**

The City of Eagle has several opportunities for residents and others who qualify to serve in a variety of ways. This is an excellent chance to give back to your community and positively impact the future of the City. Please review the information below and take a moment to apply if an opening piques your interest.

### **Transportation Committee:**

The City of Eagle is seeking residents, and others who qualify, to fill openings on the Eagle Transportation Committee. Interested parties must possess professional expertise in the area of traffic engineering, planning, road construction, and experience in the field of construction for residential or commercial development, understanding of the banking or financial field. Individuals will serve a two (2) year term on the Committee. Meetings are held quarterly (or as needed) on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday at 4:00 p.m.

### **Eagle Arts Commission:**

The City of Eagle is seeking residents, and others who qualify, to fill openings on the Eagle Arts Commission. Individuals will serve a three (3) year term on the Commission. Meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 8:30 a.m.

### **Historic Preservation Commission:**

The City of Eagle is seeking residents, and others who qualify, to fill openings on the Commissions. Individuals must demonstrate interest, competence or knowledge in history or historic preservation. Experience in the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history, urban planning, archaeology, engineering, law or other historic preservation related disciplines preferred. Individuals will serve five (5) year term on the Commission. Meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month at 5:30 p.m.

### **Industrial Development Corporation Board:**

The City of Eagle is residents, and others who qualify, to fill an opening on the Industrial Development Corporation Board. The purpose of the Industrial Development Corporation is to encourage economic development and to help provide jobs in the city by providing tax-exempt bond financing for eligible economic development projects. Under current law, that is restricted to projects which constitute "manufacturing". Individuals will serve a two (2) year term on the Board. The Board meets annually, typically in December.

Those who wish to be considered for one of the above referenced openings are required to complete a Request for Consideration form (available at [www.cityofeagle.org](http://www.cityofeagle.org) and at Eagle City Hall 660 E. Civic Ln. Eagle, ID) and submit a letter of interest. A resume or curriculum vitae are encouraged.

Applications for the Transportation Committee may be submitted to the Clerk's office at 660 E. Civic Lane Eagle, Idaho 83616 no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday August 28, 2015.**

Applications for the Eagle Arts Commission, Historic Preservation Commission, and Industrial Development Corporation Board will be accepted until all vacancies have been filled.
