OVERVIEW

The Eagle Arts Commission (EAC) in cooperation with the Eagle Chamber of Commerce is pleased to provide photographers, amateur and professional, the opportunity to submit their images for the “83616 WORKS” themed exhibit. The intent of the exhibit is to communicate the wide diversity of work endeavors that take place in the City of Eagle and the City’s Area of Impact. Awards will be presented at the “83616 WORKS Reception.” The photographs will be on display at City Hall from July 1 through July 31, 2020. Honorariums and awards are as follows: First Place: \$300.00. Second Place: \$200.00. Third Place: \$100.00 and three (3) Honorable Mention ribbons may also be awarded.

DEFINITIONS, “WORK” EXAMPLES & CHAMBER OF COMMERCE LIST

“Work” shall be defined herein as: an activity that a person engages in regularly to earn a livelihood; a specific task, duty, function, or assignment often being a part or phase of some larger activity; and/or a sustained physical or mental effort to overcome obstacles and achieve an objective or result. (Source: Merriam-Webster online dictionary.)

The following generalized “work” examples are provided to stimulate exploration of the possible range of photographic imagery: farming to ranching; commercial flower growers to commercial florists arranging flowers; bicycle repair to auto repair; manufacturing to selling; office activities to public works activities; first responder assistance to medical assistance; construction to maintenance; event planning to city planning; and dressage instruction to music instruction.

IMAGES & DOCUMENTS SUBMITTAL

1. Submittals shall be completed online at <http://bit.ly/83616WORKS> by **5:00 p.m. (MST) Friday, June 5, 2020.**
2. Late submittals will not be accepted.

ENTRY FEE & EXHIBIT INFORMATION

1. Entrants will be notified of acceptance or rejection by **June 9, 2020** by email or phone call.
2. Entries are to be framed and wired for hanging. Toothed hangers will not be permitted. See <https://www.metroframe.com/attaching-strap-hangers-wire-bumpers/> for instruction.
3. A non-refundable entry fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per entry, up to \$15.00, will be charged upon delivery of each entry. Payment by check, cash or credit card will be accepted. Checks must be made payable to the “City of Eagle.” Credit card processing fees will be applied.
4. Including the frame, entries must be no more than eighteen inches (18”) along any edge.
5. At time of drop off, entry labels shall be securely attached to the back of each respective entry.
6. The City and/or the EAC reserves the right to reject any and all submittals.
