“EAGLE IS STRONG” CHALK ART EVENT
CALL FOR ARTISTS



OVERVIEW

The Eagle Arts Commission (EAC) is pleased to provide amateur, professional and student artists the opportunity to create vivid chalk art (teams welcome). The theme is “Eagle is Strong.” The event will take place throughout Heritage Park in Downtown Eagle on Thursday, July 30, 2020 in conjunction with the Eagle Art Walk hosted by Finer Frames and sponsored by the EAC. There will be two (2) levels: The Master Level (artists 18 years and older) and the Youth Challenge (artists younger than 18).

Public safety is our top priority and CDC’s guidelines for community events will be followed. Depending on weather conditions, the event could be cancelled or moved to another date.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Each artist or team may submit one (1) sketch of their proposed artwork for review by staff and the selection panel.
2. Logos and symbols intended as advertising shall not be permitted.
3. At the discretion of City staff and/or the EAC, submissions deemed incomplete or inappropriate may not be considered.
4. The City and/or the EAC reserves the right to reject any and all submittals and waive any and all requirements set forth in this document.

SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTIONS & DATES FOR IMAGES & DOCUMENTS

1. Submittals shall be completed online at <https://www.cityofeagle.org/FormCenter/Call-for-Artist-Applications-19/Eagle-is-Strong-Chalk-Art-Event-Applicat-90> by end of the day, **Sunday, July 12, 2020**.
2. Late submittals will not be accepted.

EVENT INFORMATION, JUDGING & AWARDS

1. Chalk will be provided; however, if you are using a predominant color in your design you may want to purchase that color before the event. Only non-oil-based soft chalk/pastels in a solid form may be used. Acrylic paints, liquid pastels, oil-based pastels, hard pastels, etc. are not acceptable.
2. Artists shall be allocated a square of concrete or asphalt. Squares range from 6’ x 5’ to 8’ x 7’.
3. Artists are required to begin working on their chalk art at **2:00 p.m.** and finish by **6:00 p.m.**
4. Judging will be People’s Choice. Artists will be notified of results by email the day after the event.
5. Honorariums.
 - a. The Master Level: First Place, \$300.00; Second Place, \$200.00; and Third Place, \$100.00.
 - b. The Youth Challenge: First Place, \$300.00; Second Place, \$200.00; and Third Place, \$100.00.

EVENT TIMELINE

1. Entries must be submitted by **Sunday, July 12, 2020 end of day**
2. The “Eagle is Strong” Chalk Art Event will be held on **Thursday July 30, 2020 from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.**
